Minimum Qualifications: 3.0 GPA minimum, physical science background preferred; Upper Classmen preferred

Basic Functions: The chaperone will serve as the adult leader responsible for the safety and security of the high school students who attend the residency camp program. The chaperone is directly responsible for the group of students assigned to him or her and indirectly responsible for all high school students associated with the camp.

Specific Duties:

- Check in and check out campers into dorm. Chaperones are expected to remain at camp until all campers have been checked out of the dorms, and have left the camp site;
- Ensure punctuality and appropriate dress for all campers throughout the camp. In particular, the chaperones are responsible for informing and maintaining adherence to the code of conduct and dress guidelines for any travel, classes and other activities;
- Lead social activities during the evenings, and weekends
- Oversee the daily journaling and blogging for the camp
- Report all medical concerns associated with individual campers them to the appropriate personnel;
- Be willing to provide advice and counsel to students concerning a wide range of scientific, technical and related topics appropriate to the CAREERS camp experience;
- Assist the Camp Instructor in classroom demonstrations and lessons ;
- Provide an informal daily detailed evaluation of the camp experience to the Outreach Coordinator;
- Provide a written evaluation of the overall camp experience within seven (7) days of the camp ending date;
